Curtis Conway, a former NFL wide receiver, played for the Chicago Bears (1993-99), the San Diego Chargers (2000-02), the New York Jets (2003), and the San Francisco 49ers(2004). During his 12-year NFL career, Curtis amassed three 1,000 yard seasons. Prior to the NFL, Conway attended the University of Southern California and was a high-school All-American in both football and track.

Conway is married to Laila Ali, the daughter of Muhammad Ali and female boxing champion. They live in Los Angeles with their son, Curtis Jr.

Hamilton was the popular longtime voice of the San Diego Chargers on the legendary 77,000-watt XTRA-Radio and also did Seattle Seahawks football on KIRO-Radio, spending 13-years doing NFL games.

He has also broadcast USC Trojans football, the Arizona State Sun Devils and San Diego State, during a career that has spanned 22-years on the West Coast.

Hamilton also built a National reputation as a talk show host, anchoring the afternoon drive show on XTRA for two decades, and has been named Southern California Sports Talk show host of the Year seven times. His work has been featured on NFL Films, ESPN, Fox and Monday Night football. He also broadcast a Super Bowl game, the Rose-Fiesta-Holiday Bowl games. He has also been featured in USA Today, SI, the Sporting News and Inside Sports.

He is currently working for the XM-Home Plate Baseball Channel and writing sports columns for SDNN.com, a news website.
